Sir,

As suggested by Ministry of Panchayati Raj, an information System should be prepared so that each Panchayat could manage their socio-economic information, demographical information, public infrastructure and amenities, elected representatives and geopolitical information's of Panchayat effectively with proper records. To carry out the task National Panchayat Profiler could be used to update the above mentioned details. The URL of the site is www.panchayat.nic.in/priprofiler.

National Panchayat Portal needs to be update periodically as it would facilitate building a detailed socio-economic database for integrated planning and profile of elected representative. Basic statistics for Local Level Development (BSLLD) being collected under the Union MoStatistics scheme should be also uploaded on the Panchayat Profiler.

It is therefore requested that ACD's and DPO's of the districts may kindly be directed to update the Panchayat Profiler of their respective districts at the earliest (preferably within one month). All the technical assistance will be provided by NIC at the district level.



As suggested by Ministry of Panchayati Raj, each Panchayat should have a unique code as all the applications will string on these unique codes. Therefore, mapping of GP's to census villages and vice versa is critical for implementation of Panchayat Enterprise Suite. National Panchayat Directory can generate notifications capturing alteration of GP boundaries and Panchayat Codes will be generated automatically by the system. As per MoPR, this application should be used as workflow. The same was earlier communicated to you vide letter no RD/Panch/ 78/2009 dated 21-04-2011.

It is therefore requested that ACD's and DPO's of the districts may kindly be directed to update the data of their respective districts at the earliest(preferably within one month of receiving this letter). For any assistance, the concerned officials can contact NIC at their respective District.
